

# Arcade Multi-Use Trail Feasibility Study






#### **Public Comment - Key Findings**

- 1. There is atrong desire amongst Arcade residents to have safe, well-maintained bike trails available in their town, in order to create more opportunities for exercise and wellness. Many residents would like to pursue a more active lifestyle and to travel by means other than a vehicle, but do not currently do so, due to a lack of safe bike path connectivity.
- 2. Pride in local assets like scenic creeks and parks, as well as historic destinations like the Arcade & Attica Railroad, is strong amongst area residents who wish for such destinations to be featured along new trails.
- 3. A desire for better connectivity to Village amenities like Arcade Village Park and shopping districts was expressed by many survey respondents.


